DR. JULIET CAREY is Senior Curator of Historic and Modern Paintings and Drawings at the Fitzwilliam Museum, University of Cambridge. Previously, she was Senior Curator of Paintings, Sculpture and Works on Paper at Waddesdon Manor (National Trust / Rothschild Foundation). She co-edited *Jewish Country Houses* (2024,

Brandeis University Press), which grew out of a major collaborative research project with the University of Oxford and other partners. Carey completed the Attingham Summer School in 1999.
